COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER - DR. HAROLD B. GRAVES JR.

Harold B. Graves Jr. has served as President of Nazarene Bible College since 2006. His tenure of 15 years is the longest in the history of the college. Prior to his election as the 5th President of NBC, he was a member of the NBC Board of Trustees for 13 years and was Chairman of the Board when elected. He led the college through historic transitions including becoming a totally online institution with a leaner organizational structure, a relocated center of operations, outsourced support services, a full-time faculty serving the college from remote locations, and selling the campus in Colorado Springs.

Graves has served the Church of the Nazarene for 47 years as an associate pastor, lead pastor, and district superintendent. Through the years he held district leadership positions, served as a trustee at Mount Vernon Nazarene University and Southern Nazarene University, and on the Board of Directors of the Association for Biblical Higher Education. President Graves earned the Bachelor of Science degree in Religious Education from Olivet Nazarene University in 1974, the Master of Ministry degree from Mount Vernon Nazarene University in 1994, and was awarded honorary Doctor of Divinity degrees by Southern Nazarene University and Mount Vernon Nazarene University. He was ordained Elder in the Church of the Nazarene in 1979.

President Graves and his wife, the former Cheryl Collins, also a 1974 Olivet graduate, will celebrate 47 years of marriage in June. They have three married children and six grandchildren.



TORCH CEREMONY

The Torch Ceremony began at the first commencement in 1970. In their own words, graduates dedicate themselves to follow the call of God to carry the Light of Christ with the same dedication, faithfulness, and boldness of the first century apostles. This ceremony symbolizes the continuing mission of NBC to fulfill Christ's Great Commission.

TOWEL CEREMONY

The Towel Ceremony follows the presentation of the diploma. It is representative of Christ's washing of the disciples' feet symbolizing servanthood. The program directors will drape a towel over the arm of each graduate.



MARSHALS

Marshals contribute to ensuring Commencement is a dignified and memorable experience for graduates, their families and friends, and guests of the College.

ACADEMIC APPAREL

The academic apparel worn by the faculty and candidates indicates the degree held, the subject in which it is held, and the institution granting it. Gowns are of three kinds: the bachelor's with full, pointed sleeves hanging open; the master's with sleeves covering the arms only to the elbow and falling in narrow, rectangular panels; and the doctor's with three velvet bars and full sleeves.

The gowns are usually black, although occasionally an institution may choose a different color for the gown or trim. The hoods and tassels are of many colors and indicate the level of degree. The color of the velvet edging of the hood carried forward around the throat indicates the academic discipline: philosophy, royal blue; education, baby blue; library, lemon; theology, scarlet; music, pink; business, drab; arts/letters/humanities, white; and speech, silver. The lining colors of the hood represent the colors of the institution. Gold cords on graduates indicate that the student is graduating with academic honors.
