# **COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER**

## DR. TERRY L. LAMBRIGHT

Born in Columbus, Ohio, Terry Lambright is the second of six children raised in a Christian home. He accepted Christ as Lord while still a child and sensed a call to music ministry as a teen. In Olivet Nazarene University, he traveled in two quartets and pursued a major in English and a minor in music.

For almost 20 years, Terry served Churches of the Nazarene in Illinois and Colorado as an Associate Pastor and pursued a master's degree in music at Illinois State University. Pastoring led to a desire to minister to the whole person, and he returned to school. He finished an M.A. in counseling at the University of Colorado, took the Colorado state examination, completed the required 2000 clinical hours, and was licensed as a Professional Counselor. His desire was to teach adults preparing for ministry at Nazarene Bible College.

A door opened in 1991, and Terry Lambright joined the faculty at NBC, where he has served as professor of music, English, literature, spiritual formation, psychology, and counseling. He went back to the University of Colorado for a Ph.D. in education, with his dissertation titled "The Adult Mentoring Relationship: A Philosophic Inquiry."

Dr. Lambright saw the need for a major in counseling early in his time at NBC. It would equip students with practical helping skills, whether they felt called to pastoral care or to becoming licensed therapists. NBC launched the first Christian Counseling cohort in 1998 and a few years later added the online version – Counseling for Christian Ministries. Dr. Lambright has a part-time therapy practice which has kept him current as a counseling instructor and program director.

# TRADITIONS

## TORCH CEREMONY

The Torch Ceremony began at the first commencement in 1970. In their own words, graduates dedicate themselves to follow the call of God to carry the Light of Christ with the same dedication, faithfulness, and boldness of the first century apostles. This ceremony symbolizes the continuing mission of NBC to fulfill Christ's Great Commission.

## **TOWEL CEREMONY**

The Towel Ceremony follows the presentation of the diploma. It is representative of Christ's washing of the disciples' feet symbolizing servanthood. The program directors will drape a towel over the arm of each graduate.

## MARSHALS

Marshals contribute to ensuring Commencement is a dignified and memorable experience for graduates, their families and friends, and guests of the College.

## ACADEMIC APPAREL

The academic apparel worn by the faculty and candidates indicates the degree held, the subject in which it is held, and the institution granting it. Gowns are of three kinds: the bachelor's with full, pointed sleeves hanging open; the master's with sleeves covering the arms only to the elbow and falling in narrow, rectangular panels; and the doctor's with three velvet bars and full sleeves.

The gowns are usually black, although occasionally an institution may choose a different color for the gown or trim. The hoods and tassels are of many colors and indicate the level of degree. The color of the velvet edging of the hood carried forward around the throat indicates the academic discipline: philosophy, royal blue; education, baby blue; library, lemon; theology, scarlet; music, pink; business, drab; arts/letters/ humanities, white; and speech, silver. The lining colors of the hood represent the colors of the institution. Gold cords on graduates indicate that the student is graduating with academic honors.
