INTRODUCTION

“Perfect Storm” refers to a simultaneous occurrence of events which, taken individually, would be far less powerful than the result of their chance combination.”

Some of you may be in the midst of such a storm, or on the verge of that storm. Let me pose for you a story of an hypothetical “Perfect Storm” in life.
