

An encouraging mentor for Ministry

A person worthy of trust (vss. 6-8)

"Jethro, your father-in-law"

Someone who loves you, but is not impressed by you.

"(Moses) bowed to him respectfully and greeted him warmly."

• Someone who commands your respect, but also engenders your affection.

"Moses told his father-in-law about everything . . ."

• Someone who listens, and with whom it is safe to be transparent.

A person <u>of godly character</u> (vss. 9-12)

"Praise be to the Lord," Jethro said . . . "

- Someone with a positive attitude and a "faith" perspective.
- "Jethro . . . gave sacrifices to God."
- Someone who models a passion for and devotion to God.

A person of great wisdom (vss. 13-14, 19a)

"Why are you trying to do all this alone?"

- Someone who will help you clarify the problem. "Now let me give you a word of advice, and may God be with you."
- Someone who will offer a solution to the problem.

A **Proper Perspective** of Ministry

"Moses replied, 'Well, the people come to me to seek God's guidance. When anargument arises, I am the one who settles the case. I inform the people of God's decisions, and teach them His laws and instructions." (vss. 15-16)

It is not "my" ministry

"This is not good!" his father-in-law exclaimed. "You're going to wear yourself out — and the people, too. This job is too heavy a burden for you to handle all by yourself." (vss. 17-18)

• It is too heavy alone

A **Strategic Focus** for Ministry

Reassess your Role as Pastor (vss. 19-21a)

- "... the peoples' representative before God"
- "... teach them God's laws and instructions, and show them how to conduct their lives."
- "... find some capable men ..."

"If God directs you to do so, then you will be able to endure the pressures, and all these people will go home in peace."
